
**France** - finish your tour in the Somme Battlefield, where your students will experience walking through preserved trenches, before heading to Paris for the final days of your tour.



# HISTORY BATTLEFIELD OURS



#### Europe - United Kingdom, Amsterdam, Normandy, The Somme and Paris

Starting in London, visit the Tower of London, Windsor Castle, the Natural History Museum, The Imperial War Museum and see Buckingham Palace, Westminster Abbey, Trafalgar Square and the Houses of Parliament with Big Ben. From there visit Scotland and 'Braveheart Country', The Cotswolds, Stonehenge, Stratford upon Avon, Bath just to get you started.

From the United Kingdom travel to Amsterdam and visit Anne Frank's House, to learn about the Holocaust, how the Frank family hid from the Nazis, and the diary Anne kept.

In regional Holland, your students can learn about World War II and some of the battles that took place there. Operation 'Market Garden' was the biggest airborne operation in history.

In Normandy, visit the D-Day landing beaches, including Omaha Beach as well as the visitors centre and the memorial to the allied troops.



For WW1, visit Ypres in Belgium, attend the last post and visit the powerful Tyne Cot Cemetery - the largest in world.

On the Somme, students can walk through trenches and into No-Man's land, take in Fromelles, Pozieres, Le Hamel, and Villers-Brettoneux.

In Paris, there are a number of museums and attractions to visit including the Musée de l'Armée in Paris. Also the Eiffel Tower, Notre Dame, the Champs Elysees and Arc de Triomphe and the Palace of Versailles.



Start in Washington, take your students to the Smithsonian Institute: the world's largest museum complex and research organisation. It is composed of 19 different museums, 9 research centres and the National Zoo. After the Smithsonian Institute, visit the major sites of Washington DC, including the White House, the Capitol Building and the Arlington National Memorial as well as the National Monument.

Then head to New York, one of the world's biggest and greatest cities. Pay your respects at the 9/11 Memorial and Museum. Visit The Museum of American Finance, Wall Street, Times Square, the Statue of Liberty, Rockefeller Center, Empire State Building, Central Park, and 5th Avenue. A visit and tour of the United Nations can also be incorporated.



The world is full of amazing historical events and sites. Ancient Greece, the Roman Empire, World War I and World War II are just some of the events that helped shape the world as we know it today.

We can develop any historic tour with you to alternate destinations across the globe.



# ECONOMICS AND BUSINESS

Start in Washington, Visit the major sites including the Smithsonian Museums, White House, the Capitol Building and the Arlington National Memorial. Also the World Bank, International Monetary Fund and the Federal Reserve.

See some of the amazing infrastructure projects recently completed in China including the 55km Hong Kong - Zhuhai-Macau Bridge linking Hong Kong Island to Macau.

In Europe, visit London and receive talks at the Bank of England and leading economic think-tanks. Learn about Brexit and its effect on the UK economy and Europe. Visit Brussels and the headquarters of the European Union.


**United States** – head to New York, visit the Guggenheim, MOMA, the exclusive Frick Museum as well as the Getty Museum in Los Angeles.

Biarritz, an elegant seaside town on southwestern France's Basque coast. A symbol of Biarritz, the Rocher de la Vierge is a rocky outcrop topped with a statue of the Virgin Mary. Reached via footbridge, it offers sweeping views of the Bay of Biscay.

Chamonix, is a resort area near the junction of France, Switzerland and Italy. At the base of Mont Blanc, the highest summit in the French Alps

Lourdes, a town at the foot of the impressive Pyrenees. Visit the Pyrenees National Park before spending some time in Montpellier.

Nice and Monaco, are also attactive destinations with Saint Paul de Vence, one of the oldest medieval towns on the French Riviera.

Others options include Scandinavia, Spain, Portugal, the Netherlands, Germany, Italy and Switzerland.



Canada is an incredible country where your students will have the opportunity to visit Whistler, the national parks of Banff and Jasper, and the great plains of Calgary and Edmonton.

The United States is a vast country consisting of diverse landscapes. Highlights include Niagara Falls, the Grand Canyon, the Rocky Mountains, the beautiful New England countryside, and the volcanic landscape of Maui, Hawaii.

South America is home to the impressive Iguazu Falls on the border between Brazil and Argentina. You can also trek to Patagonia in Southern Argentina to view immense galciers.
